

## The urban epidemic of PCP abuse—laboratory and clinical studies

FERRIS N. PITTS, JR., ORM ANILINE and R. E. ALLEN

University of Southern California, Los Angeles

A glass-capillary gas chromatography nitrogen detector (GC<sup>2</sup>-N) method for phencyclidine (PCP, angel dust, wack, etc.) was developed which allows detection of as little as 1–5 pg/ml in the original sample of blood, urine, saliva, or CSF (PITTS *et al.* *J. Chromatog.* **193**, 157, 1980). The sensitivity and specificity of this method was established by GC-MS corroboration of known and unknown sample analysis. Other clinical methods are insensitive and give at least 90% false negatives with intoxication. The GC<sup>2</sup>-N method was applied to various populations to assess the frequency of use of PCP, the persistence and clearance of PCP, and the relationship of PCP use to clinical manifestations. Of 150 consecutive patients admitted involuntarily to a public psychiatric hospital in Los Angeles, 78.5% had PCP in the admission blood sample (ANILINE *et al.* *Biol. Psychiat.*, in press, 1980). Forty-four per cent of 163 consecutive patients seen in a Los Angeles public psychiatric hospital emergency room had PCP in the admission blood sample; a record study revealed that all patients with PCP in blood had at least one evidence of toxic psychosis although only about 20% of the PCP-positive patients had the proper clinical diagnosis (40% were called schizophrenic and 40% affective disorder) (YAGO *et al.* *J. Clin. Psychiat.*, in press, 1980). A prospective clinical study of 200 consecutive patients admitted to Los Angeles public psychiatric beds revealed that 70% had PCB in blood, and all those positive for PCP had evidences of toxic psychosis and/or acute delirium to a systematized minimal-status examination; only a few of the patients manifested the nystagmus, hyperthermia, hypertension, seizures and other manifestations thought to be characteristic of PCP abuse (PITTS *et al.*, in preparation, 1980). Three of four consecutive major burn cases admitted from explosive fires had PCP in blood, although all denied making and using the drug (YAGO *et al.* *Biol. Psychiat.*, in press, 1980). A 65-yr-old psychotically depressed Chicana complained that she was being poisoned by first floor neighbours putting fumes into her bathroom from below; she was found to have PCP in blood from the fumes and azotropes from the illegal PCP lab in the flat beneath hers (ANILINE *et al.* *J. Clin. Psychiat.*, in press, 1980). Law enforcement personnel confiscating and handling PCP report clinical intoxication symptoms, and have PCP in blood samples; those not handling PCP have negative blood for PCP; one laboratory officer who had been away for more than 6 months on other duties without PCP contact (after several years' handling of the confiscated materials) had 78 ng/ml in blood which cleared completely into urine with acidification but recurred (presumably from lipid stores) 2 weeks after discontinuance of the NH<sub>4</sub>Cl (PITTS *et al.*, to be published). Infants born of mothers who have used PCP, and wives and infant children of "dusters" have been found with PCB in blood; the former receive PCP from cord blood and the latter presumably have inhaled PCP smoke from the air in their households (PITTS *et al.*, to be published). Studies of dusters have revealed variable phenomena indicating multiple compartment transportation-storage of PCP in humans with persistence for periods of at least 6–12 months after last contact (PITTS *et al.*, to be published). There is a specific relationship between PCP in urine and urine pH; no matter what the blood level of PCP (up to 10 mg/ml in our current experience) there is no PCP in urine of pH 6.7–6.8 and above. Below pH 6.7, however, much or nearly all of blood PCP is rapidly excreted into urine (ANILINE *et al.*, to be published). Vast

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quantities of PCP are stored in lipids of brain and other organs after PCP use and equilibration, and these stores can provide the source of continued low blood levels for extended periods. Gastric fluid (if acidic) and saliva levels of PCP are always higher than those of blood. Continued use of PCP over extended time can result in a toxic psychosis ("wack attack") in users who have apparently experienced only mild euphoria and dissociation with each prior usage. Alternatively, PCP can infrequently cause toxic psychosis with the first use due to large dosage and/or idiosyncrasy. The half life of PCP in blood after initial dosage is 2–3 hr, and PCP blood levels do not always correlate with the degree or type of clinical manifestations. Then, too, clinical tolerance develops. For these (and other) reasons we have seen patients with "wack attacks" with only picogram/ml blood levels and persons with minimal symptoms with milligram/ml blood levels. Urine PCP is an unreliable method of diagnosis of PCP intoxications since patients with "wack attacks", or even PCP coma, often have alkaline PCP-negative urines. PCP is little metabolized, long stored, and has delayed psychiatric effects in man. It is not biodegraded and is manufactured in bulk (hundreds of kilos) in thousands of illicit sites in this country by unsophisticated persons using few or no precautions to prevent contamination of neighborhoods. The makers and users become extremely violent and dangerous to themselves and others. Chronic users (and non-users who have been exposed) manifest dulling of intellect and function that is semi-permanent or permanent.

PCP use is epidemic in urban areas, and its use is spreading to the very young (in elementary and junior high schools). Its use is also spreading to the middle and upper classes from the lower socioeconomic urban centers (and from certain ethnocultural groups to all American society). PCP represents one of the greatest public health threats to human society and deserves careful study so that effective treatments of intoxication and prevention of use-abuse can be developed.



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It seems like this was the primary objection "clinicians," clinical psychologists and psychiatrists such as Dr. Belsare, had to my "lifestyle" - "Seriously. Why are you such a shlub? OBVIOUSLY you're smart, and you're GOING NOWHERE!"

Well, this was an entirely incorrect perspective on the way I have conducted my life; I've always had INSANE levels of ambition... just not along conventional lines?

So I directed my ambitions towards engaging in PRODUCTIVE WORK that would influence social development in favorable ways, focusing eventually on computer programming - and "stuck in Ithaca," like so many other people, I wound up seriously UNDERpaid... but NOT underemployed, because following years of hard study in Computer Science and beginning to write my own C language program for a terminal application I called "dumb virtue," I lucked into a position at Cornell working for the (brilliant!) Dick Cogger on similar applications specifically developed to serve Cornell, and our "just behind the leading edge" style of network hardware and software development...

... two years later, when Dr. Belsare wrote this evaluation, it was taking time for sales of dataComet to develop to the point I had hoped - about \$100,000 a year? - however, I was (as usual) KICKING ASS by serving a clientele spanning a broad range of applications for the product: educational institutions (Cornell in all its glorious branches including Agricultural Extension and the Weill School of Medicine, the University of Pennsylvania, and the Australian Graduate School of Management to list just a few), manufacturers (e.g. Apple Computers, Lockheed-Martin, and Allied Signal - "Prestone" antifreeze!), and most amazing of all - NASA Headquarters in Washington, DC!

Nobody seemed to pay attention to my analysis of this tragic case of an Adverse Drug Reaction, despite the fact that I had prepared and distributed a restrained critique of the performance of the OMG clinicians in my case thus far, and laid out my analysis of the Prozac/Trazodone -> mCPP interaction in a reasonably clear manner ‡ -

Thus, I was extremely frustrated with the situation when I presented my to Dr. Belsare down at the Elmira Psychiatric Center for a routine interview, following being transferred down there from supervision by Tompkins County Mental Health, where I had been supervised by Linda Riley LMHC, an excellent forensic therapist... just after experiencing episode of Brief Psychosis prior to my transfer where I was hospitalized at Cayuga Medical Center for five days, which psychosis, as it turns out... was clearly caused by smoking marijuana that had been spiked with PCP?

The indifference with which clinicians viewed my extensive documentation on my Adverse Drug Reaction of 1997 was the root cause of the "UNDERLYING HOSTILITY AND PARANOIA" that Dr. Belsare noted:

I'm a "little bit paranoid" due to suffering from Temporal Lobe Epilepsy... but not so much that I have significant problems with it, because I am aware of this and compensate for it by applying EXTREME SKEPTICISM to any ideas I might develop regarding "wicked motives" on the parts of others?

I am keenly aware of this, because I have made quite a few in the course of developing software! (LOL) At any rate...

Having been transferred down to the EPC, I continued to work with my therapists and was SMOKING MARIJUANA REGULARLY, as they noted in their records, although when they asked for urine samples, I refused... since I was sick and tired of paying for them, and a response along the lines of "I plead the Fifth Amendment!" pretty obviously implied that I was still smoking, right? The penalty for the possession of under 25 grams (just under an ounce) of marijuana is a \$100 fine. Why make such a big deal out of it, when I had been smoking on a regular basis for 20 years, with BENEFICIAL effects both in my my RELATIONSHIPS and my work as a computer programmer?

Secure application, adding support for the "Shiny Brand New" Mac OS X in a major effort to shift the application over to function properly with the underlying UNIX-based system; I sweated over each new release, because with the broad range of uses to which dataComet was being put to my clients... "somebody might get killed DEAD!"

But alas I was thwarted again in the year 2003, when it is now clear that I was poisoned AGAIN... the marijuana I relied on to maintain such phenomenal results as a programmer was AGAIN spiked with PCP!

IN MASSIVE QUANTITIES, so I was a raving psychotic for five whole days?

I accepted the diagnosis of "Bipolar Disorder" or "Psychosis NOS" (Not Otherwise Specified) offered by my doctors... however, my skepticism about these diagnoses grew as I reflected on nature of the illness I had suffered, and sometime around March 2014 following looking into the records on my presentation at the time, I realized that they fit the pattern of PCP intoxication PERFECTLY...



## DUMB VIRTUE -- Virtual terminals on the Mac under UNIX

Kevin Eric Saunders, Project Manager

Cornell's Laboratory of Atomic and Solid State Physics (LASSP), having committed itself to the purchase of 10 Macintoshes to be used as terminals for its VAX-11/750 running under 4.2 BSD UNIX, is currently developing windowing graphics terminal software for the Mac. We are using Stanford University's SUMACCS C-language cross-compiler for the Macintosh; the SUMACCS+UNIX+VAX development system provides an environment distinctly superior to that of the Lisa Workshop's "enhanced" p-system OS. In addition to offering superior utilities, edit-compile-go cycles are reduced to around 2 minutes on the VAX.

The current (.01) version, which has been hacked out of the SUMACCS translation of grow, performs (slow) serial communications with 4.2BSD UNIX, and uses TextEdit calls to store, edit, and display in a single resizable window. The next improvement to be made to the program will be the generalization of the window-management code to handle multiple text windows.

Eventually, the package should support:

- Different window types to support UNIX shell interaction, editing using the vi full screen editor, and graphics;
- The association of Mac windows with UNIX processes; and
- File transfer capabilities so that Macintosh files can be up/downloaded to/from 4.2BSD machines.





Dear Janel,

This letter transmits source and object code for part of the Omnitalk facilities, according to the agreement between Corvus and Cornell of June 16th, 1988. You will also be receiving under separate cover an invoice covering the remainder of the amount called for in the contract.

The software included supports a bridging application which runs in the background on a normal Mac+. Included are: a listing of the source code, and a floppy containing various source files, documents, object files, scripts, and the like to be used in Apple's MPW environment. This material is described in Attachment 1. to this transmittal letter. Attachment 1. also provides explanation of several design issues and other useful information.

The performance of this implementation is limited by the singly-buffered nature of the Corvus omnidriver, for the same reasons as described at the time we sent the Mac Omnitalk implementation. We hope to have a proposal prepared soon for a follow-on project to rewrite of this driver to increase performance.

We have a partially working implementation of Omnitalk for the PC, using the TOPS card, but my understanding is that you have no real use for that code. Although Apple and Novell have announced a jointly developed architecture for PC driver support (OLI) which should provide the base for developing the sort of PC Omnitalk you and we would want, we have not been able to obtain the code yet.

## NOTES ON THE OMNITALK WORKSTATION/BRIDGE CODE

There are a number of factors which have affected the final form of the system.

### PURE WORKSTATION CASE:

The Omninet driver for the Macintosh does not perform double-buffering, so the AppleTalk LAP code must return ASAP to the Omninet driver so it can get another buffer and set up another receive on the Omninet card. In the case where the driver is handling large packets, several retries are common; with bursts of small packets, more than ten retries are often necessary, so the driver sends the packet three times if necessary.

**Synchronicity:** Unfortunately many calls to the AppleTalk driver are made synchronously, so upcalls to the AppleTalk stack cannot rely on obtaining cycles from a driver (such as the .bridgeDA) running in "normal" time but must instead perform the upcalls synchronously from interrupt level. Due to the problem mentioned above, we therefore use the millisecond timer to trigger the upcall.

**Memory:** Apple has had several conflicting (and confusing) approaches to allocating memory for drivers, and the technique used by the Omninet driver does not work for an Alternate AppleTalk implementation. At Alternate LAP install time, which occurs early in the Startup process before INITs are called, memory in the System Heap is limited, so the 'CVIT' resource is truncated so the system will fit. Unfortunately this resource includes the timer for OmniDrive services, so the current version does not support OmniDrives.

### PURE BRIDGE CASE:

In the bridge case the forwarding of packets is performed during "normal" time by getting cycles from the .bridgeDA. Forwarding of packets at interrupt time leads to failure. Alas, some Mac applications, notably the Finder, are less than generous when providing driver cycles through calls to SystemTask, slowing bridge performance. (The "race" application demonstrates the effect—the MPW Shell also shares cycles properly.)

**Memory:** The bridge requires numerous buffers, so the following solution was worked out: at Install time, the OmniTalk code defers memory allocation, instead opening the .bridgeDA driver and calling it with pointers to routines to initialize OmniTalk and service its queues. Later, at INIT time, the System calls the 'OmniINIT' INIT, which contains an 'sysz' resource which causes the

System to expand the System Heap, and which then calls the .bridgeDA to complete the initialization of OmniTalk.

#### MIXED WORKSTATION/BRIDGE CASE:

This case adds another complication: NBP calls often need to be performed synchronously, producing two broadcast packets from the bridge in the case where the Zone names are identical, yet the AppleTalk .MPP driver is not re-entrant. This case has been handled for the Mac+ by patching the .MPP variable containing the WDS, but this has not been fixed for the MacSE/II/etc. This requires obtaining the .MPP version # and the corresponding location of the stored WDS for each version.

*Bonze Anne Rose Blyk*

This memorandum recommends a raise and eventual reclassification for Kevin Saunders in recognition of major changes in the nature, scope, and level of his job duties over the past two years. I would be recommending a reclassification at this time but understand there is a freeze in effect now. It is also the case that Kevin has been able to rise to these new requirements, expanding his scope and accepting greater responsibility.

Probably, Kevin should have received a reclassification some time ago, but the value and level of technical work is not always immediately evident. In my experience, it is a common occurrence for a programmer in the early years of his career to work along, making progress but not able to do really outstanding work until a certain point. At such a point, accumulated experience allows the person to "put it all together," to produce a major achievement. Kevin first reached that point in the fall of 1988 on the Omnitalk project, but various outside considerations resulted in this work not being used, so Kevin did not receive the general recognition he merited. Kevin reached a further level in synthesizing an important result this past July and August when he forged the Comet Terminal Emulator program from a number of components he had been working on previously. Fortunately, this work is being generally released and not only demonstrates Kevin's ability but will serve to establish his reputation in the networking community as well as at Cornell. Beyond the level of technical work required, in bringing this product out, it was necessary for Kevin to perform a complex series of co-ordinations and deal with a level of administrative and other interactions beyond what is usual at his current level.

Kevin has also requested that his position be returned to half-time (20 hrs./wk instead of 39), as it was prior to January of 1988. Although I

believe he would make faster progress professionally working full time, I understand that he has personal reasons for limiting his commitment to part time. At this point, Kevin has raised his level of contribution substantially and can, in my opinion, go on to broaden his capability at a fair rate over the next two years, even working part time.

Kevin is currently classified at level 34, Systems Programmer III, within the current technical job classification system. His current salary is \$27,768. He has now over 5 years experience. I believe his current classification and salary levels were somewhat below what they should have been as of a year ago, for his general experience and capabilities, and the disparity is now substantial, given the level at which he has been working during the past year and more.

I believe that Kevin should now be classified as Tech Specialist I at grade 36. His salary should be approaching the mid thirties (in full-time terms) and be above the mid thirties a year from now.

Anticipating that it may be difficult to bring Kevin all the way to where he should be in a single step, I propose a program aimed at moving him to the proper level over the next 18 months. I believe that a significant salary increment will be an appropriate first step. With a normal merit raise in July, an additional mid-year increment a year from now should bring him almost to the level where he should be. In the course of the classification study, his level will be considered, and I believe a reclassification to level 36 will turn out to be appropriate.

I'm not sure exactly what effect the new system being piloted in CIT will have, but I believe this recommendation is compatible with both the current system and the new one. Accordingly I propose the following program:

1. Effective 2-1-91 (or as soon as processing can be completed):

Raise approx. 16% to \$32,200 (\$16,514 at 20/39 time)  
Reduce to 20 hr/wk.

2. Effective 7-1-91:

Raise approx. 5% to \$33,800 (\$17,333 at 20/39 time)  
(assumed normal SIP increment)

3. Effective with the completion of the classification study:
-

Reclass to Tech Specialist I, level 36 — Not Done.

4. Effective 1-1-92:

Raise approx 10% to \$37,200 (\$19,077 at 20/39 time) — Not Done.

Naturally, steps 2., 3, and 4. cannot be committed at this time, but represent a plan and an expectation, contingent on performance, results of the classification study, and on other factors, of what will be necessary to fairly recognize this valuable employee's advancing job level, capabilities, and contributions.

Attached is a proposed job description to describe the changed position proposed for Kevin.
