Dear Mr. Berry:

Due to your abusive conduct towards me in our last meeting at the Ithaca City Court on April 19 2019, during which you raised your voice to me in order to intimidate me and stated that "we agree" - "You and what Army?" (LOL) - that I am somehow required to seek "mental health care and treatment" from Tompkins County Mental Health and ONLY from that service prior to trial, you are hereby discharged as my attorney.

Your evident determination to have me enter a plea of Guilty and submit to an unfavorable "plea bargain" in response to the unsubstantiated charges I face dating from September 19 2018 of Trespassing, Obstruction of Government Authority in the 2nd Degree, and Resisting Arrest at Denny's Restaurant (323 Elmira Rd. Ithaca NY), to which I have already entered my plea of Not Guilty on all counts before Judge Miller in a formal appearance before the court, on the ludicrous claim that I am somehow in need of "official" mental health care services on an involuntary basis constitutes a disgrace to the legal profession to which you claim to belong; further attempts to falsely present yourself as my attorney-at-law shall, I pray, be met with disbarment.

Due to your dereliction of duty as my attorney, I shall perforce present myself as attorney pro se in my own defense at my next court appearance on May 22 2019, since other competent lawyers - with whom I am long familiar in this community, where I have resided for nearly 40 years - have disdained to represent me, for reasons that are not quite clear, other than that they may be aware they are not be fully capable of doing so in light of the long-enduring persecution I have suffered at the hands of incompetents, malcontents, and some few evil-minded torturers in the "mental health community" who believe that I was "guilty" in my arson offense of February 6 1997 - when the plain truth is that I was acquitted of the offense in Tompkins County Court on July 28 1997 by Judge Barrett, acting on behalf of the People of New York State, in conformity with the M'Naghten Rule as enacted by the Legislature of New York.

Ithaca PD on scene advised 950 to upgrade response due to onset of difficulty breathing. 950 responded immediately without use of lights and sirens, and arrived to find a 62 year old female lying prone on floor of restaurant with her hands restrained behind her back, accompanied by Ithaca PD. Initial BLS Assessment: Patient was alert and oriented to person, place, and time. Patient presented with a patent and self-maintained airway, as evidenced by her ability to speak in complete sentences. Patient was breathing non-labored on room air, with brief spells of hyperventilation. Patient presented with good cardiovascular function, as evidenced by brisk capillary refill. Patient presented with obvious bleeding from the nose, though not active at time of assessment. Patient was able to sit and move to standing position, and was escorted to stretcher by law enforcement. Patient was secured to stretcher with safety belts. Ongoing BLS Assessment: IPD 126 advised EMS that patient was combative, and that 126 punched patient in the nose during altercation. Patient was uncooperative with EMS assessment, but reported pain in the area of her nose. Patient experienced brief spells of hyperventilation. Patient denied difficulty breathing, stating that was just how she breathes. Vital signs were attempted. Patient was transported BLS to CMC, with report given to facility during transport. Patient was moved to room 10 via stretcher, and moved to hospital bed via 4-person blanket lift. 1. Male-to-female transsexual

The main barriers are due to risks for cardiovascular disease. She took estrogens for less than 1 year previously 2014. She took spironolactone 100 mg bid for 4 years. She had a good response - breast growth. She would like to restart that dose. My main concern is hyperkalemia. We will check the labs frequently.

Verbal informed consent - knows the risks:

- increased risk of MI, CVA and DVTs

Wants to go ahead.

- BMP, serum or plasma
- estradiol 0.1 mg/24 hr weekly transdermal patch

2. History of Deep vein thrombosis

This occurred while on the estradiol. She was on injectable estradiol and wasn't smoking at the time. I recommend she takes an aspirin 81 mg qdaily while on this medication. I will check D-dimer along with the potassium
